





**Location**: Never share your home address or current location publicly. Disable mobile GPS. **Information**: Be conscientious in sharing pictures & personal information.

Avoid Arguing Bear Testimony Cite Sources

If your account is hacked or you see inappropriate content, consider:

Closing the Browser: Shut down the internet broswer you're using. If necessary, restart your computer.

Asking for Help: If another user violated your privacy, posted innapropriate content, or threatened you, report it. If you have questions or concerns, talk to a trusted friend or leader.

**Deleting the Account:** If worst comes to worst, it may be wise to delete your account. Stepping away is a safe solution. Consider starting fresh as you feel impressed to do so.

**Profile View:** You can view your profile as others view it. Every so often, make sure your profile is secure from strangers.



**Unfollowing:** You can unfollow people without blocking them so they will never know that you aren't receiving their updates.



**Messaging:** People that aren't your friends can still private message you. Be aware of who is interacting with your children.

## **Advice to Parents**


